Admission to Ph.D. Programme2026

Applications are invited for admission to the Ph.D. Program for session 2026-27 for the following subjects:

Archaeology, Computer Science, Management, Physical Education, Education, Yoga, Social Work, Agronomy, Soil Science, Entomology, Plant Pathology, Horticulture, Zoology, Botany, Biotechnology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Accountancy, Business Administration, English, Hindi, Sanskrit, History, Music, Sociology, Geography, Economics, Political Science, Jyotirvigyan, Psychology, Law, Homeopathy, Physiotherapy

Admission to Ph.D. Program will be made through Research Entrance Test (RET) followed by interview as per as per University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022.NET/JRF qualified candidates are exempted from written entrance test. If seats remain vacant after the admission of NET/JRF-qualified candidates, the university will conduct its own Entrance Test to fill those remaining positions. Application Form and other details will be available on the website jnrnvu.edu.in from 11.05.2026. Last date of submitting application is **31.05.2026**.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A candidate shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. Programme if they have completed:

1. A 1-year/2-semester Master's programme after a 4-year Bachelor's degree, or
2. A 2-year/4-semester Master's programme after a 3-year Bachelor's degree, with at least 55% marks or an equivalent grade in aggregate.
 - Relaxation of 5% is applicable for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS/PwD categories.
3. Holders of a 4-year Bachelor's degree with a minimum of 75% marks (or equivalent grade) may directly apply for admission to the Ph.D. programme.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1 Notification and Application

The University shall issue a public notification through its website and leading newspapers, specifying available seats, eligibility criteria, entrance examination details, and interview schedule.

Admissions are based on merit, following the Government of India's reservation policy.

2 Admission Methods

Method	Description
A. National Eligibility Tests	Candidates qualifying UGC-NET, UGC-CSIR NET, GATE, CEED, etc., will be exempted from entrance tests and called for interview directly.
B. University Entrance Test	Conducted by Janardan Rai Nagar Rajasthan Vidyapeeth. The syllabus is based on the UGC-NET pattern.
C. Weightage Criteria	Entrance Test: 70%; Interview: 30%. Candidates must secure at least 50% in the entrance test (5% relaxation for reserved categories).
